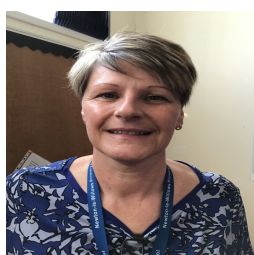

I also teach across our Key Stage 2 classes and mentor our Newly Qualified Teachers to ensure they are supported.

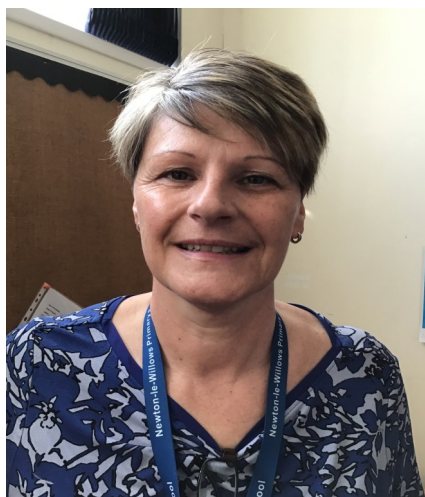
It may sound like a cliché, but my favourite thing about working at Newton is our children! They are so hardworking, caring and fun to be around.
