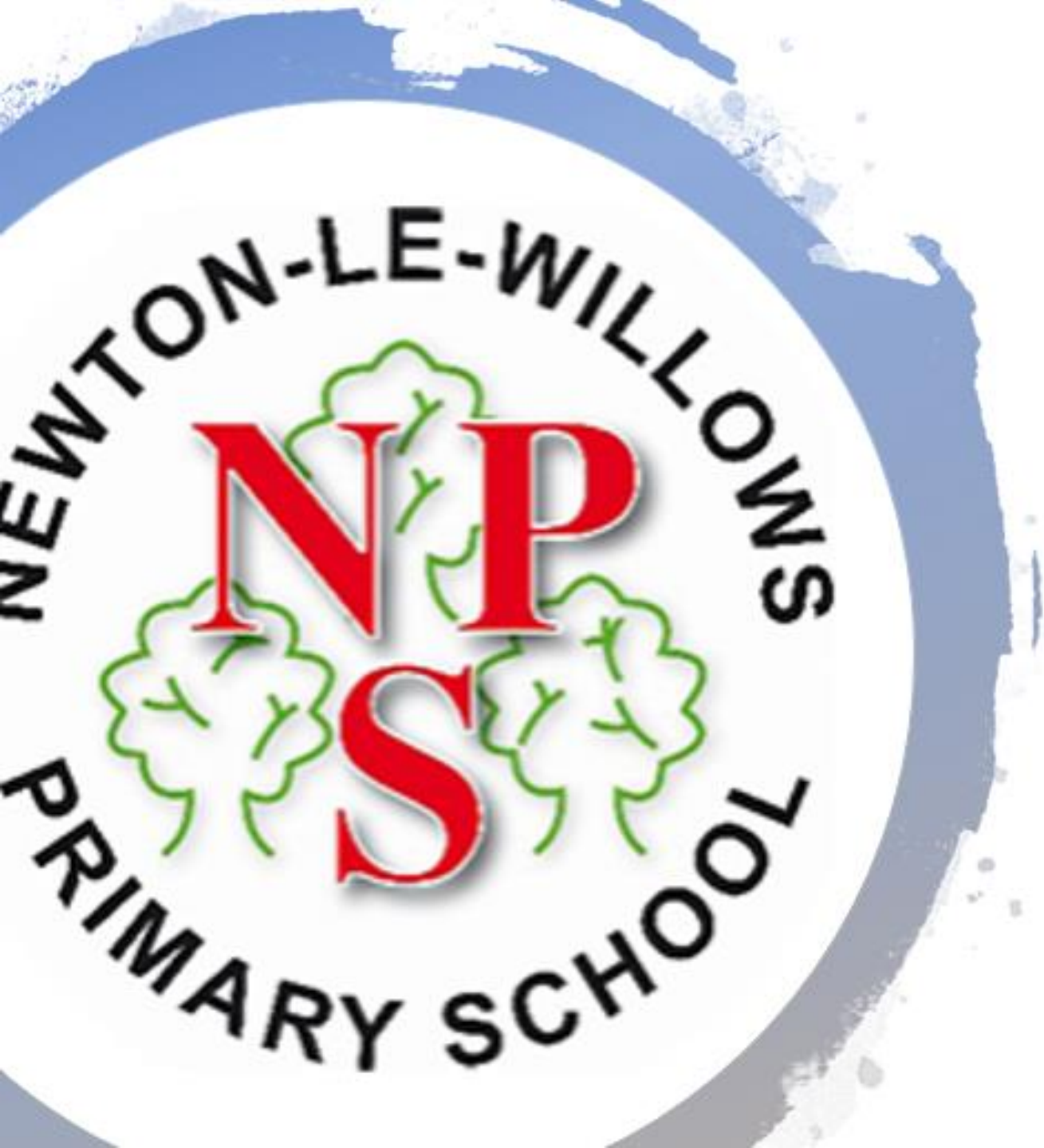


Growing and Changing

Boys/girls

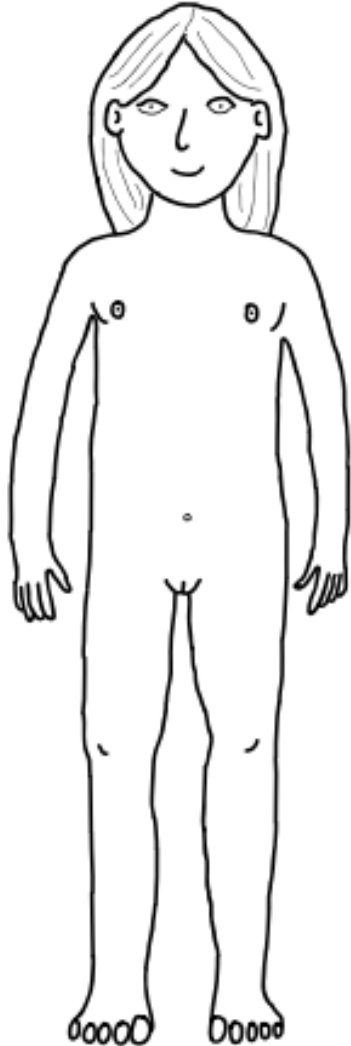
- Whilst there are lots of things that are the same about all children, one difference comes from when babies are born and the midwife/ doctor says whether they are male (boy) or female (girl) by looking at their body parts.
- Your private parts are the parts of your body that we keep to ourselves, we cover with underwear. Your private parts will determine whether you are male (boy) or female (girl).
- Female genitals can look different, just like our eyes can be different and male genitals can look different too.

Private parts/ genitals

- You may have heard of lots of different names for genitals. What names have you heard for
 - Female (girl) genitals?
 - Male (boy) genitals?
- It is important that we use the scientific words for them and learn these.

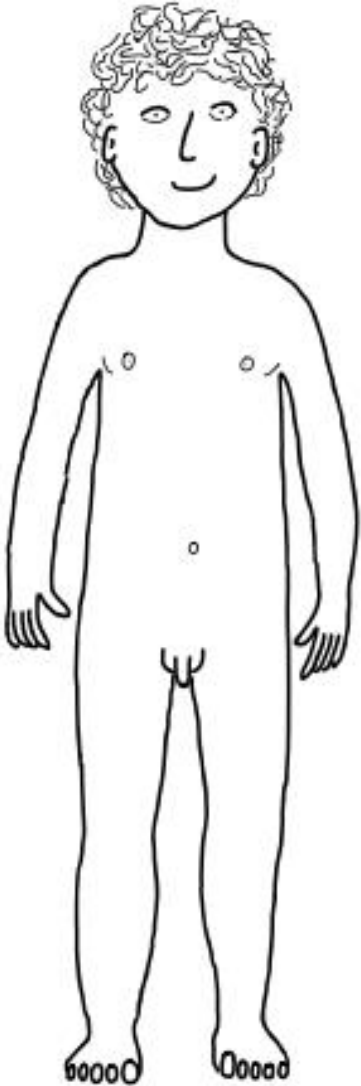
Female genitalia/ private parts

- The private parts of a girl is called the vagina.



Male genitalia/ private parts

- The private parts of a boy is called the penis and testicles.
